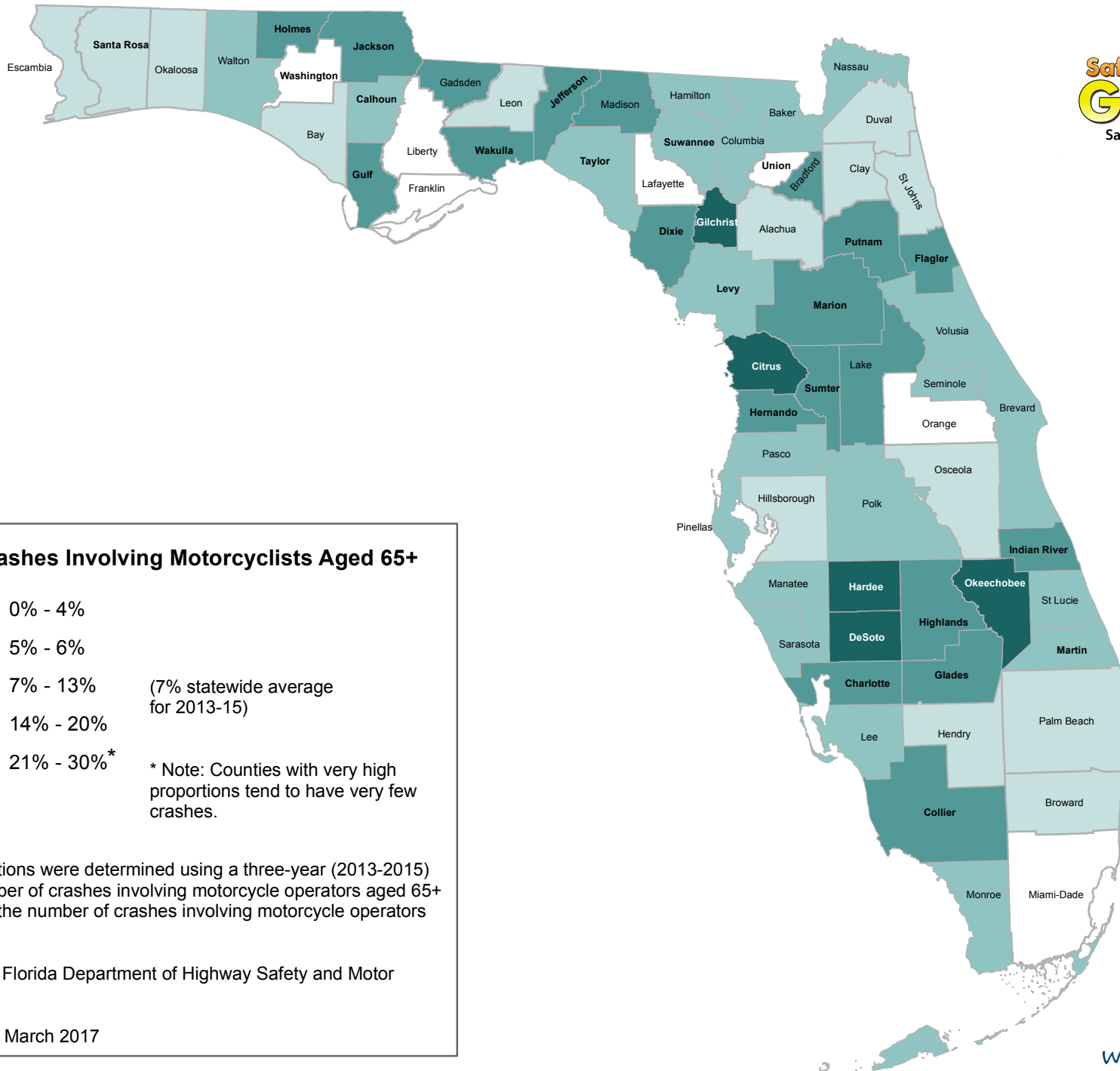


Crashes Involving Motorcyclists Aged 65+
